BACKGROUND

Fisheries and aquaculture of the Asian region have been, drawing increased attention as an avenue for food and nutritional security, livelihood, employment, investment and trade. Asia's contribution to the world fisheries and aquaculture has been significant and growing. The Australasian region is emerging as a major player in fish production, diversification, value addition and trade.

Fisheries scenario in the world has been passing through a difficult period due to stagnation in yield from capture, increased operational cost, reduced profitability, emerging concerns of sustainability, globalization, biodiversity loss, pollution, environmental degradation, loss of critical habitats, marginalization of small scale fishers, processors and vendors, increased cost of feeds, high operational costs in fish culture, diseases, brood stock management, low productivity, market dynamics and several other factors. Developing countries of the Asian region are at higher risks as millions depend on fisheries for livelihoods. While we are passing through a phase of threats and destabilization, it is time that the fisheries scientists take upon themselves the challenge of addressing these issues through strategic and anticipatory research leading to interventions which will ensure not only long term sustainability but also make fisheries and aquaculture a rewarding, environment friendly, socially acceptable and economically profitable activity. It is with this focus, the 8th Asian Fisheries Forum has chosen the theme "*Fisheries and Aquaculture: Strategic Outlook for Asia*".

ABOUT THE ASIAN FISHERIES SOCIETY

The Asian Fisheries Society, established in 1986, is the largest fisheries non governmental organization in the Asian region with a membership of over 3000 scientists, technocrats, fish farmers, administrators and activists. The AFS has been holding the Asian Fisheries Forum once in every 3 years since its inception. The Society is now organizing the 8th Asian Fisheries Forum in Kochi, India from 20-23 November, 2007. The AFS endeavours to make the 8th Asian Fisheries Forum the largest fisheries gathering in the Asian region.

THE CONFERENCE

The theme of the Conference shall be "*Fisheries and aquaculture: Strategic outlook for Asia*". The Conference will be from 20-23 November, 2007. There will be several simultaneous technical sessions, a poster session, two symposia, a trade exhibition and post forum tours.

THE VENUE

Kochi, **the Queen of the Arabian Sea** has been selected by the AFS as the venue of **8th Asian Fisheries Forum, 2007**. Kochi is rightly called the fisheries capital of India. There are many fisheries organizations, fishery related activities such as fishing, aquaculture farms, processing plants, exporting firms, quality control labs, fish feed factories, fish farms, fish traders, fishery equipment suppliers, exporters, research

institutes, etc. located in and around Kochi. In addition to this, Kochi, situated in *God's Own Country, KERALA*, one of the top notched tourism destinations in the world with an average of 350,000 foreign tourists visiting every year is popular as the 7th most attractive tourist destinations in the world as per international rating. The Forum will be held at *Le Meridien Resort & International Convention Centre*, Kochi which is situated in the outskirts of the city of the Kochi. The port city is well connected by over 170 domestic and over 150 international flights per week as well as by rail and road. The **SAFF2007** will be an opportunity for scientists from various countries to present their research outputs and interact to develop collaborative research and development agenda for future.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Technical sessions will be covering the thematic areas listed and will run concurrently. Selected papers will be allocated slots for presentations. The selection of papers for oral presentations will be based on the quality of abstracts submitted by the authors. Detailed instructions will be available for authors on abstract preparation and submission in the website as well as in the second announcement.

POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Authors are encouraged to present their papers in the equally important poster sessions which will be open for thematic areas. Detailed instructions on preparation of the posters will be available to intending authors.

TRADE EXHIBITION

All major players in the Asian fisheries and aquaculture scenario will take part in the 3 day trade exhibition arranged at the venue of the Forum. The exhibition will attract research, development, industry, trade, products, services, information technology and allied sectors. Details of charges and floor plans are available at the website.

Only registered participants will have the privilege to participate in the inaugural session, welcome get together, scientific sessions, special symposia, conference lunch and tea, conference banquet, trade exhibition, cultural evenings and post forum tours.
